LOCAL — BAY AREA

- Anti-Police Terror Project (fiscally sponsored by Affect Real Change) is an Oaklandbased and Black-led organization supporting families surviving police terror, organizing events, and bailing out protesters.
- National Lawyers Guild San Francisco Bay Area Chapter (fiscally sponsored by Bay Area Community Law Foundation) - National Lawyers Guild for the Bay Area Anti-Repression Committee Bail Fund brings together progressive lawyers, law students, legal workers and jailhouse lawyers to protect and defend communities, social justice movements, and political and grassroots organizations and activists organizing for their self-determination and rights.
- **Black Organizing Project** works for racial, social, and economic justice through grassroots community organizing and policy-change.
- **BlackOUT Collective** (fiscally sponsored by The Ruckus Society) provides direct action trainings and on-the-ground action support.
- Silicon Valley De-Bug is a storytelling, community organizing, and advocacy organization based in San José.
- Showing Up for Racial Justice (SURJ) Bay Area (fiscally sponsored by Institute for Democratic Education and Culture – SpeakOut) is part of a national network of groups and individuals organizing white people for racial justice.

NATIONAL

- Black Visions Collective (fiscally sponsored by TakeAction Minnesota Education Fund)
 centers their work in healing and transformative justice principles, intentionally develops
 the organization's core "DNA" to ensure sustainability and develops Minnesota's
 emerging Black leadership to lead powerful campaigns.
- National Police Accountability Project protects the human and civil rights of individuals in their encounters with law enforcement and detention facility personnel.
